- 3 or 4 more teams to India next summer/Fall

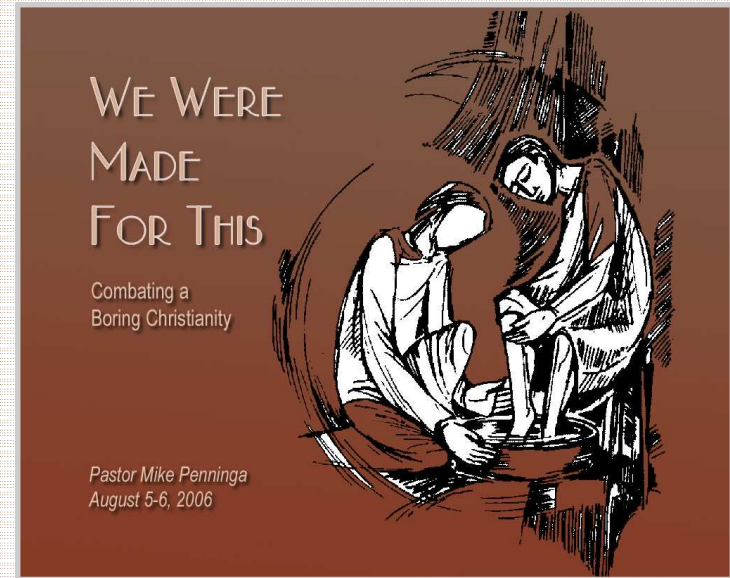
