## **SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS**

2 Corinthians 12:9

"My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

As you open your small group time together, read through this passage and spend a few moments contemplating the encouraging words Paul penned. Think of times this past week when you felt utterly weak, or faced a tough meeting, or an uncertain moment. Now let God remind you of his power, his sufficiency for your life. Pray that God would continue to remind you of his promise in the days to come.

Vincent Van Gogh is quoted as saying, "How can I be useful, of what service can I be? There is something inside me, what can it be." As Christians, we know both the who and how of this compelling questions. We have Christ in us. We have love ingrained in our souls. We have a mission clearly set out before us. As we studied in Galatians 5:25-26 this past week, the Life of the Sprit, the Life we have chosen impacts every aspect of our lives. It is how we are to "do" life. We may never be more like Christ than when we are serving; serving out of pure love and a purely selfless motivation.
